

# HADEN HILL SWIMMING CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS CONDITIONS

1. The Championships, under ASA Laws and ASA Technical Rules shall be competed for annually. The Promoter's shall agree the dates of the competitions.
2. Entry to the competitions shall be open to all members who have been fully paid up members of the Club for at least 2 months before the closing date for entries in the year of competition.
3. The Promoter will however reserve the right to restrict entries in the interests of safety and sound meet management.
4. Fully paid up members with less than 2 months membership, or who are 2<sup>nd</sup> claim members, can compete but they will do so on a time only basis.
5. Only competitors with 1<sup>st</sup> claim membership and those satisfying condition 2 will qualify for awards.
6. The ages for all events will be as at 31 December in the year of competition.
7. Completed entry forms (or equivalent entry confirmation schedules), together with any fee, determined by the Promoter must be returned to the Club's nominated representative by 10:15 pm on the date agreed by the swimming committee. Under no circumstances will entries be accepted on the day of competition.
8. Members are responsible for the validity of their entries form and incomplete or inaccurate submissions will forfeit the swimmers right of entry to the competition along with any entry fee(s)
9. Swimmers can enter the following events:
  - 8 years and under – All 25m events
  - 9 years – All 50m and 200m events
  - 10 years and over – All 100m and 200m events
10. Events will be seeded by submitted time from PB database. In other cases where the swimmer wants to enter an event over a distance and stroke but has no recorded time the swimmer should tick the event they wish to enter and write 'N/T'. The computer will seed these entries in the slowest heats. Results will be declared on a heat declared winner (HDW) basis.
11. Age Group categories and events for the Championships for both sexes will be:

Note: Swimmers in this age group may not enter shaded swims

11. Awards, agreed by the Promoter, will be for both sexes in all age groups:
  - The Championships will determine the Junior and Senior Club Championship awards for both sexes
  - Trophies/medals will be awarded to the top 6 swimmers in each group category.
12. Junior shall be defined as 10-13 years and a Senior as 14 years and over on the 31<sup>st</sup> December in the year of competition
13. The overall Junior and Senior trophies for both sexes shall be awarded according to the summation of points accrued for each swim in the 10/11; 12/13; 14/15; 16 and over age groups. Where the summation of points is equal in the calculation of Junior and Senior trophies the trophy shall be shared
14. Where the result is a tie for any event involving an award the participants will receive equal awards.
15. Alterations to the Conditions will be agreed by the promoters.
16. The event is run under ASA Laws and ASA Technical Rules and the ASA Laws on Open Competitions shall cover any laws not covered in the promoter's condition.
